Sub: Modifications in Qualification Criteria for EPC Projects -reg.

MoRTH vide Circular No. RW/NH-24036/28/2025-BP&SP (Computer No. 248457) dated 29.04.25 & Circular No. RW/NH-24036/28/2025-BP&SP (Computer No. 248457) dated 08.07.2025 issued certain changes in the qualification criteria of EPC Projects (copy enclosed). Relevant provisions of the standard RFP of EPC Projects stand modified to this effect.

2. It is to be noted further that some corrections are required in the above cited Circulars keeping in view subsequent Circular dated 10.07.2025 issued by MoRTH for HAM Projects. In addition, certain modifications are also required to be implemented. Accordingly, the circulars cited at Para-1 above shall be incorporated in Standard RFP for EPC Projects with the following further modifications:

For the avoidance of doubt, it is clarified that 'similar completed work' shall mean a completed work comprising all major components similar to the work for which bid has been invited. Execution of work, which does not include all major components, shall not be considered as completion of similar work. Furthermore, in order to claim experience for similar completed work, the bidder must submit the Experience Certificate attached at Annexure-IX of Appendix-IA, in addition to the certificate from the Statutory Auditor/Client as specified in Annex-IV of Appendix-IA.

For the projects executed by NHAI, the Experience Certificate shall be issued by the concerned GM (T) at NHAI HQ based on the recommendation of the Project Director

Subject: Modification in Qualification Criteria for EPC Projects - reg.

Ref: Standard RFP for EPC Projects issued by Ministry's Letter No.RW/NH-37010/4/2010/EAP (Printing) Vol.-IV dated 05.03.2019 and its subsequent Amendments.

Sir.

The Ministry vide letter No.RW/NH-37010/4/2010/EAP (Printing) Vol.-IV dated 05.03.2019 and its subsequent amendments has specified the qualification criteria for contractors for EPC Projects. Numerous relaxation in the qualification criteria for eligibility in case of EPC contracts were given in 2019 to promote competition.

- However, now it has been brought to the notice of the Ministry that the said relaxation in the qualification criteria has had a detrimental effect on the quality of construction.
- 3. In view of the above, the Ministry has revised/modified the qualification criteria of contractors for EPC contracts. The modifications made, inter-alia, include the minimum requirements for both standard highway construction projects as well as stand alone specialized projects such as tunnels, major bridges, ROBs, flyovers etc; a higher requirement for EPC projects with bid price over Rs 100 crore; checks on sub-contracting experience and modification of the highways and core sector definition to tighten the eligibility criteria. The modifications in detail are enclosed as Annexure.
- Relevant provisions of the standard RFP of EPC Projects stand modified to this effect.
 All the executing agencies of the Ministry are directed to implement the aforesaid changes with immediate effect.
- This issues with the approval of Hon'ble Minister (RT&H).
