Policy Circular No. 9.4.32/2025 dated 08th November, 2025

Sub: Amendment/ Modifications in the list of Equipments mentioned in Standard RFP Document of PBMC Mode for O&M Works - Reg.

The Performance Based Maintenance Contract (PBMC) RFP document along with the SOP for preparation of Estimates was issued by MoRTH vide letter dated 06.07.2023 and the same was circulated vide NHAI Policy Circular No. 9.4.25/2023 dated 07.08.2023 for implementation.

2. Now, the Maintenance Manual of NHAI has been circulated vide NHAI Policy Circular No. 9.4.31/2025 dated 27.09.2025. The Manual guided for the use of Latest Technologies/ Equipments i.e. "Automatic Pot Hole filing, Compacting & Patching Machine" and "Mechanized Road Sweeping Machine" for effectiveness in routine maintenance.

3. Accordingly, with approval the Competent Authority, it has been decided that latest Technologies/ Equipments i.e. "Automatic Pot Hole filing, Compacting & Patching Machine" and "Mechanized Road Sweeping Machine" (with specifications as stipulated in NHAI Maintenance Manual) shall be incorporated in the list of Equipments to be deployed by the PBMC Contractors as under:

- i. For the Projects which are under Bidding stage, the said Equipments to be incorporated in the of Equipments in RFP through Corrigendum.
 - ii. For the Projects under pipeline, the said Equipment's to be made part of Equipment's list in standard RFP Document of PBMC work.
 - iii. For the Ongoing Projects, the said Equipment's to be deployed by PBMC Contractor with the approval of the concerned Member through for which additional cost implication shall be borne by NHAI. In this regard, a *Standard Operating Procedure (SOP) with Cost Assessment Parameters shall be issued separately.*
4. Other provisions of RFP shall remain unchanged.
5. This issues with the approval of Competent Authority.
